**Beginning on July 4, 2021**, the following protocols will be in place for anyone (except platform people) attending the Sunday Celebration Service. All the Protocols listed below will continue unless reconsidered by the Board of Trustees.

► The Sunday Celebration Service will be offered Live on Facebook, on the Church Website and in the church sanctuary. As you read these agreements, remember that we work with physical facts and yet we know the spiritual Truth. We can be guided by facts and at the same time know divine wholeness and health. Our Board will review and may alter these policies as needed.

### By registering to attend, you agree to the following:

- You will not hold Unity of Greater Hartford liable for any injury and/or illness (including contracting the novel coronavirus which causes COVID-19) that you may incur as a result of participating in events on Unity of Greater Hartford property.
- If after attending this service or visiting the building you test positive for COVID-19, notify local health officials and communicate with Rev Christine (610-348-6276 or [revchris@unityhartford.org](mailto:revchris@unityhartford.org)) about potential exposure for others. The church may need to inform those in attendance about possible exposure. Your identity will not be released.

### Additionally please follow these mandatory church protocols:

- If you are feeling ill or if you have a fever, please stay home and not come to the church.
- Only those who have pre-registered online or have read and signed these Protocols in person may attend the Sunday Service.
- If you are fully vaccinated you no longer need to wear a facemask in the church building or on the church grounds. You may certainly choose to wear a facemask.
- **You must wear a face mask at all times** (covering your mouth and your nose) in the church building or on the church grounds if you are **NOT** vaccinated or only partially vaccinated. This is not negotiable and there can be no exceptions.
- **Children** aged 2 and older must wear a face mask (covering their mouth and nose) in the church building or on the church grounds if they are **NOT** vaccinated or only partially vaccinated. This is not negotiable and there can be no exceptions.
- **Singing** in the Sanctuary is not allowed.
- The church will have free single packaged masks and sanitizing lotion available.
- The kitchen and community room are now open for Fellowship. Please bring only store brought finger foods to share. Napkins and toothpicks will be available. Please take home with you any of your food offerings that are not consumed.

- In the church atrium there will be a wooden locked box for your tangible Love Offering checks and cash. No credit cards will be accepted on-site. You may give by credit card though our website.
- Please feel encouraged to express your preference in giving or receiving hugs.
- The Bookstore will not be opened
